

Your local youth soccer clubs need your help.

Many of our referees have let their registration lapse and can no longer be assigned games. We need your help to provide the best possible soccer experience here in Stockton.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

If you have been a referee – Renew your registration now so you can work games this Spring or Fall. All of the steps can be completed online. Go to www.cnra.net/new-referee/ for instructions. Start now because it will take several weeks to complete the process. If you are over 18 you will have to complete a USSF background check before you can complete your registration. Once you have your license update your profile at www.gameofficials.net, link it to Group#1310 and enter the days and times you are available to referee games.

If you know someone who would like to be a referee – Encourage them to take the online new referee course if they are 13 years of age or older. Remember that referees are paid for each game they work. Registration instructions are found at www.cnra.net/new-referee. Any of the listed new referee courses offered in the area can be taken. When you start the course send us a message at President@sierravalleysoccerreferees.org so we can send you information about buying referee equipment and uniforms.

Once you have your referee license - Create a referee profile at www.gameofficials.net and link it to **Group #1310**. This is the program our assignor uses to notify you by text or email of your game assignments and directly deposit your pay into your bank account. You also enter the days and times you are available in GameOfficials so our assignor knows when you want games.

New youth referees will be reimbursed for the cost of the referee course by working 12 Stockton Youth Soccer Association games. Most referees work two or three games on a weekend so that is 4 to six days of referee work.
